

Task Force Questions

The interviews were open-ended, and for the most part the interviewer invited the interviewee to talk about his or her own experiences. The following questions were asked if the information did not emerge spontaneously during the interview.

1. How do you see the current situation in AATA? How would you characterize it?
2. What is your honest view of "transparency" and "confidentiality" in AATA matters?
3. What is your current (or what was your past) role in AATA?
4. If you resigned or signed the no confidence letter, what led you to do so?
5. If you are currently serving, what is it like? What's working? What's not working? What would help you to do your job better?
6. Is there any information you would like to share that would help us to get a more three-dimensional picture of the truth? If so, please be as specific as possible.
7. From your perspective, what factors do you see as contributing to this situation?
8. What recommendations would you make to help resolve this situation?
9. Is there any one or several person(s) you feel you want to have a mediated encounter with? What issue would you want to discuss with them?
10. As you consider looking at all perspectives that have been contributed to this situation, what is your understanding of those positions that are contrary to the viewpoints you hold?
